Artist description:

Originally trained as a chemist and pharmacist, Edward John Burrow was born in Somerset and studied at Cheltenham College, later settling in the spa town. Active as a topographical etcher and draughtsman, he established a cooperative publishing business in Cheltenham in 1900, through which he wrote and published several books of local interest, such as *The Ancient Entrenchments and Camps of Gloucestershire*, first published in 1919, and *Around and About Cheltenham*, published in 1921.

Many of Burrow's etchings are commissioned views of public schools and colleges such as Marlborough, Rugby, Eton and Haileybury.
